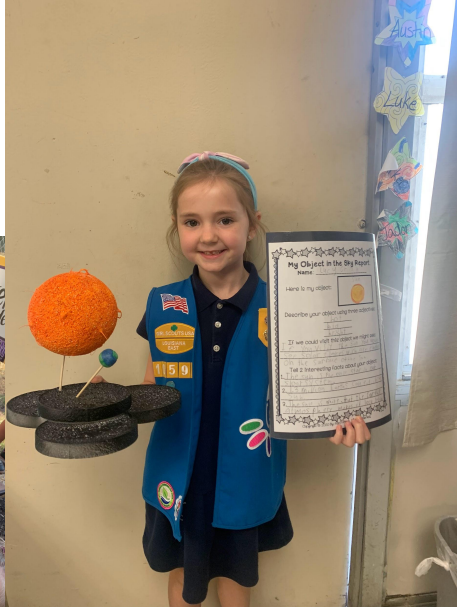

(STUDENTS TAKING AWESOME RESPONSIBILITY)

Binder should be sent to school every day and checked every night. This is how we send home notes, conduct, and homework. We ask students to check the front pocket each morning for any notes from home.

Please remove completed classwork work each day and initial your child's conduct sheet.

FIRST GRADE REMINDERS:

Homework and Yellow Envelopes

Homework packs go home on Friday. The spelling Tic-Tac-Toe homework activity is located in students binders.

Homework packs and Spelling practice are due on the following Friday.

Students will be getting a math homework workbook to pull out weekly math homework pages. These workbooks are to be kept at home. Pages should be handed in with your child's homework packet.

If students forget to turn in homework, they may turn it in Monday.

Yellow envelopes will be sent home every other Wednesday. They will contain all graded work. Please sign the front of the envelope and return all papers.

MAYFAIR 1ST GRADE ETC.

- Please leave toys, jewelry, and trading cards at home.
- If you send a lunch with your child, please keep in mind students only have 20 minutes to eat. Be sure to pack things your child can open on their own.
- If students would like water throughout the day they need to bring a water bottle.
- There are only 2 school approved parties per year. They are Winter and End of Year.
- We do not celebrate birthdays in first grade. Students can bring individually wrapped goodies to pass out at the end of the day.
- Students are learning the procedures and routines of first grade. The transition is sometimes hard after the summer. Please give them time to adjust.

FYI: GRADING

- Reversals in letters and numbers are not counted incorrect at the beginning of the year, as it is not uncommon for this age.
- During the fall semester unanswered questions on tests are returned to students to be completed. In the spring semester unanswered questions will be counted wrong.
- Parents can access students grades anytime on Jcampus. If you need help accessing Jcampus you can contact Ms. Shari in the front office.

MAGNET STATUS REQUIREMENTS

Elementary Magnet School Requirements:

As per the EBR Magnet Contract, elementary students must pass the grade level in order to maintain magnet status. In accordance with the EBR Schools Pupil Progression Plan, elementary students must earn four quality points in ELA, Math, and either Science or Social Studies. In addition, students may not earn consecutive Fs in the third and fourth nine weeks in the same subject.

CLASSROOM DOJO

- Be sure you are registered in Class Dojo before the first day of school **August 8th**.
- Parents have been invited to their Classroom Dojo through email or text.
- Dojo as well as email will be the main way for you to communicate with teachers.
