→ Homework packets go home on Fridays and do not need to be returned.


→ The packets include homework pages for all subjects and any study guides or other information.

### Fluency Homework



#### Handout 1A: Fluency Homework

Dear Parents.

Welcome to our classroom! This year your child will be receiving regular reading fluency practice for homework. Fluency homework helps build your child's confidence with reading.

Each week of fluency homework, your child has a passage of text upon which to focus.

On the first homework assignment with a new passage, we want students to be able to say every word clearly and to know what the passage means. If they accomplish just that much, please check off the expectation.

On the second assignment, we want students to chunk the words as they read. We all do this when we speak! The easiest way to do this is to read to a comma or a period. For poems, this means reading the lines as if they had a comma or period. We encourage you to read aloud with your child and to play with the phrasing.

The third day might be the most fun. Encourage your child to be dramatic and theatrical! Choose the words that carry the deepest meaning for emphasis. Say those words more boldly, being sure to continue the phrasing.


