


LATE WORK POLICY

Middle school students will receive the following credit for late assignments:

- 1 class period late a student can receive up to 80% credit for late assignments.
- 2 class periods late a student can receive up to
 60% credit for late assignments.
- 3 class periods or greater late a student will receive 0% credit for late assignments.

If a student missed a test during an absence, he/she will have **two** class periods to make it up or make other arrangements. If not made up in the given time period, the student will receive a zero.



Chromebook Repair Costs


